## Parents Active in Catholic Education

### **What is P.A.C.E.?**

P.A.C.E. (Parents Active in Catholic Education) is the School Club renamed and reorganized to consist of parents & teachers working together to help promote greater family involvement in our school.

### **Why P.A.C.E.?**

As we follow the current guidance of our Catholic School Diocese, a new format of school club has been developed.

### **What is the goal of P.A.C.E.?**

The number one goal of P.A.C.E. is to keep our school tuition down. In order to meet this goal, we need family involvement in our school's fundraising and everyday functions.

### **What are the P.A.C.E. requirements?**

Each PCS family will be required to earn 8 PACE Points *per* student.

(One point is equal to approximately one hour of service)

For example: If you have 3 students enrolled at PCS, you must earn 24 P.A.C.E. POINTS

### **How can I earn P.A.C.E. Points?**

P.A.C.E. Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 🐾 Room parent
- 🐾 Fund raising committee or chairperson
- 🐾 Market Day
- 🐾 T.R.I.P. helper
- 🐾 Library volunteer
- 🐾 Coordinator of any social activity – e.g. Fun Fair, Book Fair etc.
- 🐾 Athletics - e.g. volunteer coaches
- 🐾 Student activities – e.g. chaperoning events, transporting students to activities, etc.

### **Is there another way to earn P.A.C.E. Points?**

Yes! You can earn points by participating in our TRIP Program. For every \$500.00 spent on TRIP, a P.A.C.E. point will be given.

- 🐾 *A family can fulfill P.A.C.E. Point obligations by electing to pay off their points - \$25.00 per month per child for eight months.*

**\*A family will be charged \$25.00 per service point not completed by May 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**Any combination of service hours, TRIP points & payoff is acceptable.**

***Other opportunities may be approved by the Principal.***
